Dear colleagues,

The taxonomy of dermatophytes is changing dramatically by the application of combined clinical, morphological and phylogenetic data. Publications will appear soon, wherein Trichophyton will largely be restricted to anthropophilic species and their close neighbors, while most geophilic species will be classified in other genera.

This will probably make life easier in the routine dermatological lab. We judged it is the right moment for The ISHAM-affiliated Working Group Dermatophytes to organize a **Workshop on recent advances in dermatophyte research**.

The workshop will be organised at the CBS-KNAW Fungal Biodiversity Centre, Uppsalalaan 8, Utrecht, The Netherlands, on Saturday 29 and Sunday October 30, 2016.
